

JimSam College Scholarship

Purpose: The JimSam College Scholarship is awarded annually in June to a graduating high school senior who has demonstrated hard work and commitment in the game of tennis while providing service and leadership within Timberhill Tennis club and the local tennis community. Recipients of the JimSam College Scholarship are expected to attend an accredited public or private four-year college or university in any state that awards a bachelor's degree. The first place scholarship is typically valued at \$2,000.

Application: To be considered the applicant must submit: 1) a completed application; 2) three sealed letters of reference; 3) an essay with a maximum of 300 words that describes the role that tennis has played in your life, how it has helped shaped you as a person, and how it will continue to impact your future during and after college; 4) a professional resume that includes your educational experience, community service, work experience, extracurricular activities, and tennis rankings, achievements, etc.; 5) a high school transcript that includes courses completed through the first semester of your senior year.

Criteria: The award criteria is based upon the applicants academic achievement, professional resume, professional interview, essay, and the tennis pro's evaluation of the player's sportsmanship, commitment to a long-term consistent work ethic and positive impact within Timberhill Tennis Club and the local tennis community.

Selection: Candidates are scored on a 1-5 scale by a committee of reviewers based upon their submissions, letters of recommendation and the criteria above.
